Easter Sunday – April 3, 2021

Many Christians celebrate Jesus Christ's resurrection on Easter Sunday. The Easter date depends on the ecclesiastical approximation of the March equinox.

Is Easter Sunday a Public Holiday?

Easter Sunday is not a public holiday. It falls on Sunday, April 4, 2021 and most businesses follow regular Sunday opening hours in the United States.

What Do People Do?

Many churches hold special services on Easter Sunday, which celebrate the Jesus Christ's resurrection after his crucifixion. Many people also decorate eggs. These can be hard boiled eggs that can be eaten later, but may also be model eggs made of plastic, chocolate, candy or other materials. It is also common to organize Easter egg hunts. Eggs of some form are hidden, supposedly by a rabbit or hare. People, especially children, then search for them. In some areas, Easter egg hunts are a popular way for local businesses to promote themselves or may even be organized by churches.

Public Life

Easter Sunday is not a federal holiday but a number of stores are closed in many parts of the US and if they are open, they may have limited trading hours. In some cities, public transit systems usually run their regular Sunday schedule, but it is best to check with the local transport authorities if any changes will be implemented during Easter Sunday.

Background

In Pagan times, many groups of people organized spring festivals. Many of these celebrated the re-birth of nature, the return the land to fertility and the birth of many young animals. These are the origins of the Easter eggs that we still hunt for and eat.

In Christian times, the spring began to be associated with Jesus Christ's crucifixion and resurrection. The crucifixion is remembered on Good Friday and the resurrection is remembered on Easter Sunday. The idea of the resurrection joined with the ideas of re-birth in Pagan beliefs.

Symbols

For people with strong Christian beliefs, the cross that Jesus was crucified on and his resurrection are important symbols of the period around Easter. Other symbols of Easter include real eggs or eggs manufactured from a range of materials, nests, lambs and rabbits or hares. Sometimes these symbols are combined, for example, in candy models of rabbits with nests full of eggs. Eggs, rabbits, hares and young animals are thought to represent the re-birth and return to fertility of nature in the spring.

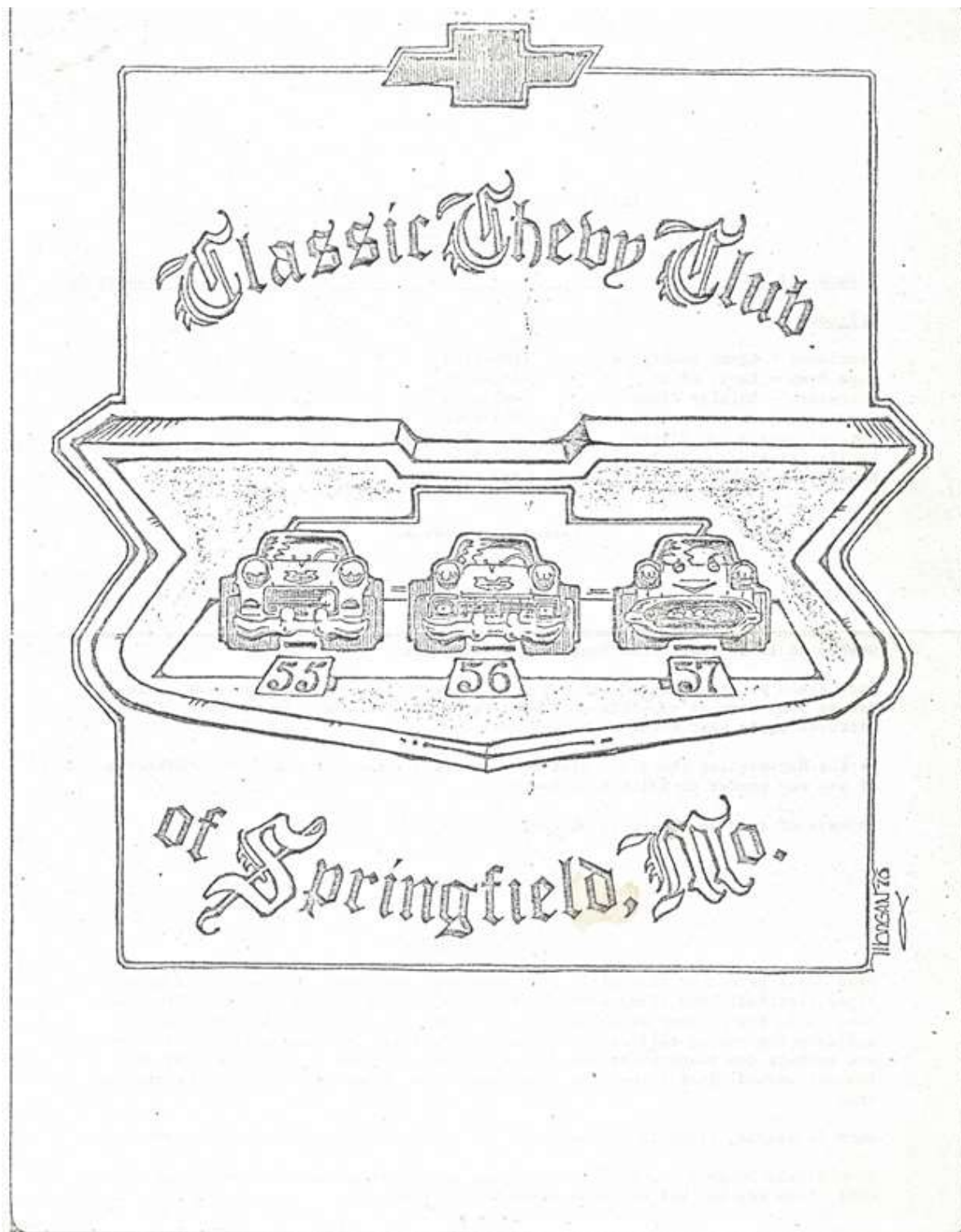

CLASSIC COOKER

TEXAS SHEET CAKE - Dorcas Sears

2 cup sugar	1/2 cup milk
2 cup flour	1 tsp. baking soda
1 stick oleo	2 eggs
1 cup shortening	1 tsp. vanilla
1 cup water	4 tbsp. cocoa

Mix sugar and flour in large bowl. Put oleo, shortening, water, and cocoa in saucepan. Bring this to boil and pour over sugar and flour mixture. Beat eggs, add baking soda to milk. Combine eggs, milk and vanilla. Add to other mixture and blend in well.

Bake in greased pan at 400° for 20 minutes.

Frosting

1 stick oleo	1 tbsp. vanilla
4 tbsp. cocoa	1 box powdered sugar
6 tbsp. milk	1 cup chopped nuts if desired

Using same saucepan, melt oleo, add cocoa, milk, vanilla, and powdered sugar. Beat, spread on cake while hot and sprinkle with nuts.

SPECIAL "K" BARS - Dorcas Sears

1 cup white syrup
1 cup sugar

Mix and bring to a boil. Add 1 cup crunchy peanut butter. Pour over 5 cups of Special K cereal and spread in 9x13 greased pan.

Icing

1/2 stick melted butter	1/2 tsp. vanilla
2 tbsp. cocoa	1/2 box powdered sugar
3 tbsp. milk	

Melt oleo, add cocoa, milk, vanilla and powdered sugar and mix together. Ice bars then cut in squares.

SWMO Hot Rod Hundred (Willard to Crane) – April 3, 2021

2021 SWMO Hot Rod Hundred Route Plan

Willard Community Center to Crane City Park - 103 miles and approx 2 hours 15 minutes drive time.

From Willard Community center, **TURN RIGHT** to travel through Willard to Hwy 160 (1.3 miles)

TURN RIGHT onto **HWY 160 W** and continue to the intersection of **MO 123 North** (3.1 miles)

TURN RIGHT onto **MO 123 N** towards to intersection of where **HWY 215** turns **LEFT/Westbound** (17.9 miles) There is a convenience store at this intersection on the SW corner of intersection

TURN LEFT onto **MO 215 W** towards and through **BONA, MO.** (9.6 miles) **CROSS TRAFFIC DOES NOT STOP** at the **STOP** sign in **BONA, MO** (intersection 215/245)

CONTINUE STRAIGHT on **MO HWY Y** to **MO HWY H** (4.4 miles) Son Sac Depot convenience store on south side of road

TURN LEFT/SOUTH onto **St Hwy H** to **Hwy 160 E** (9.2 miles) (just across the bridge, there are permanent porta potties in the Ruark Bluff Beach park on the East side)

TURN LEFT onto **HWY 160 E** and continue towards **EVERTON, MO** (13.7 miles)

TURN RIGHT onto **MO HWY M / SPRINGFIELD ST** to go through **EVERTON** towards **HWY 96** (7.5 miles)

(there is some rough pavement through this section and a one lane bridge)

TURN RIGHT to continue on **HWY M** and continue south to **HWY 96** (5.6 miles)

At this point **HWY M** turns **RIGHT/South** and **HWY Z** continues straight. Make sure to take **M**

TURN LEFT/EAST onto **HWY 96** - **USE CAUTION** as there will be traffic both ways traveling 60ish MPH - Continue for 0.6 miles

TURN RIGHT onto **LAWRENCE COUNTY RD 2062** (Route 66 Scenic Byway to the Historic Spencer Route 66 station. The pavement is rough, so take it slow. (1.2 miles)

TURN RIGHT/South onto **HWY N** to **HWY 174** (6 miles) (convenience store east of intersection)

CONTINUE STRAIGHT onto **HWY K** - (**USE CAUTION CROSSING 174** as cross traffic is traveling 60ish MPH) to the stop light in **AURORA MO** at **CHURCH ST/Business 60** (10 miles)

At the stop light **TURN LEFT** onto **BUSINESS 60/CHURCH ST** to **HWY 60 E** (2 miles)

At the stop light **TURN LEFT** onto **HWY 60 E** (3.4 miles to **HWY 265**) (bio brake location if needed)

TURN RIGHT onto **HWY 265** (3.1 miles) (Turn just before the Dairy Queen)

TURN RIGHT onto **HWY 413** to the **CRANE CITY PARK** (6.7 miles)

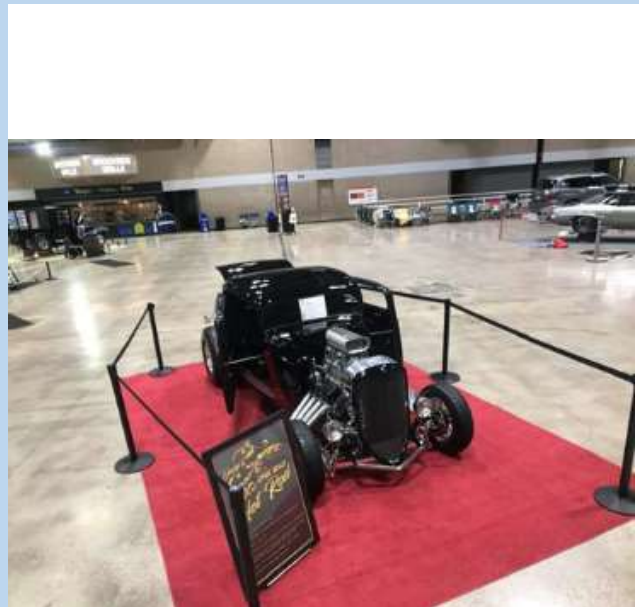
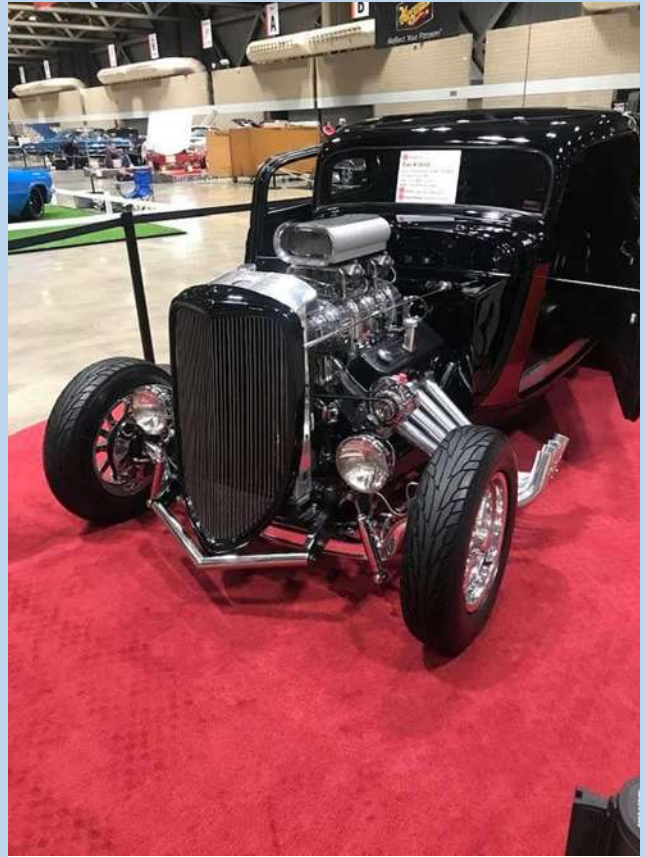

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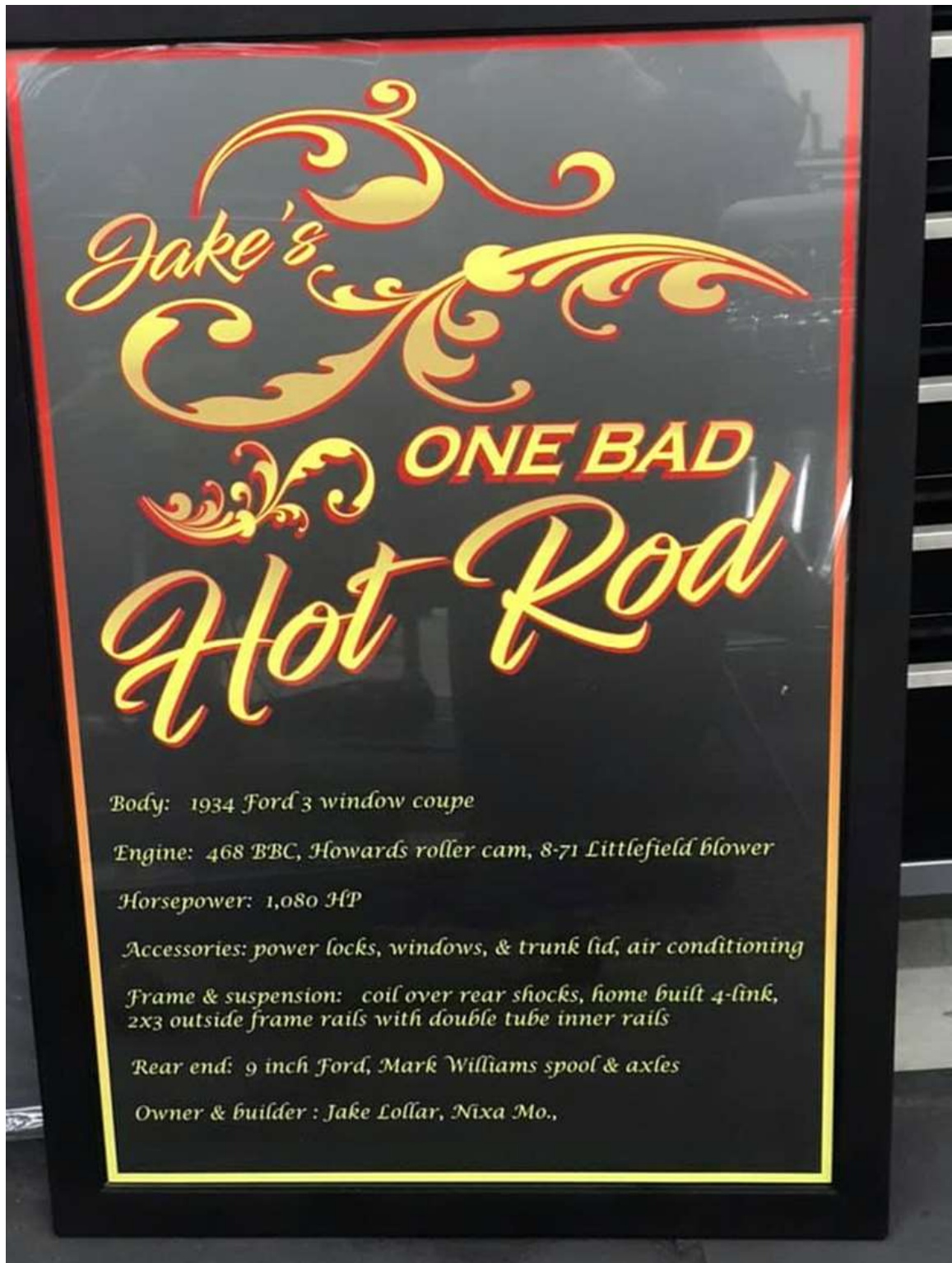
