Remember When....

A fun romp through the decades as we approach our clubs 45th anniversary in July 2020.

Highlights from 1958-1960...

1958 reflected a softer, more luxurious Chevy. They were longer, lower, wider, and heavier, but not really slower than the lighter '57's. Underscoring all this change was the new line-leading 1958 Impala, a lush Bel Air subseries offering convertible and Sport Coupe hardtop with six or V-8 in the \$2600-\$2800 range. Impala sale in 1958 accounted for 15% of the 1.1 million cars sold by Chevy that year. While Chevy showed restraint in bucking tailfins for '58, it made up for that the following year with another all-new body bearing huge "cat's-eye" taillal aps and a "batwing" rear deck. (Information adapted from *The Encyclopedia of American Cars.*)

Under the direction of Louise Zibold Reiss, a physician, the Tooth Survey collected hundreds of thousands of baby teeth from children born in the 1950s and 1960s in the St. Louis metropolitan area, using them to measure exposure to radiation from aboveground nuclear weapons tests conducted during the early years of the Cold War. St. Louis's Baby Tooth Survey became a marvel of environmental activism, and its findings led to significant policy changes regarding nuclear weapons testing.
