Remember When.....

A fun romp through the decades as we approach our clubs 45th anniversary in July 2020.

Highlights from 1958-1960...

1958 reflected a softer, more luxurious Chevy. They were longer, lower, wider, and heavier, but not really slower than the lighter '57's. Underscoring all this change was the new line-leading 1958 Impala, a lush Bel Air subseries offering convertible and Sport Coupe hardtop with six or V-8 in the \$2600-\$2800 range. Impala sale in 1958 accounted for 15% of the 1.1 million cars sold by Chevy that year. While Chevy showed restraint in bucking tailfins for '58, it made up for that the following year with another all-new body bearing huge "cat's-eye" taillamps and a "batwing" rear deck. (Information adapted from *The Encyclopedia of American Cars*.)

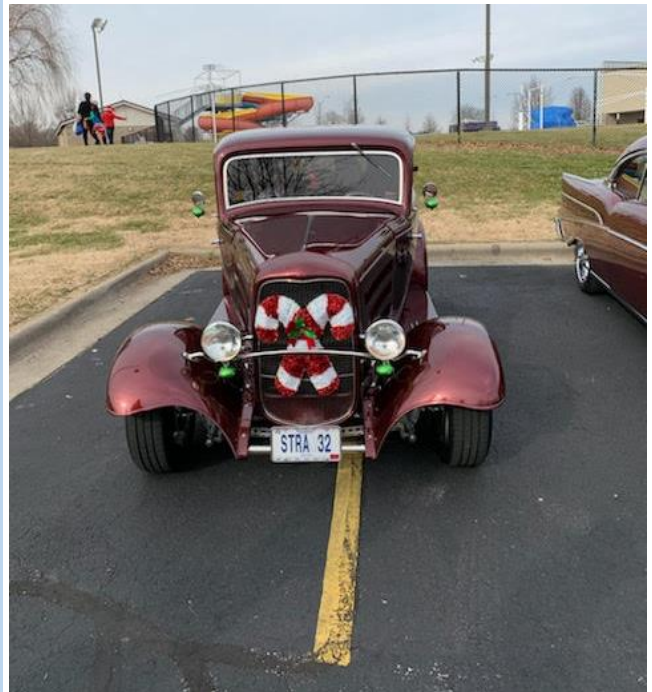
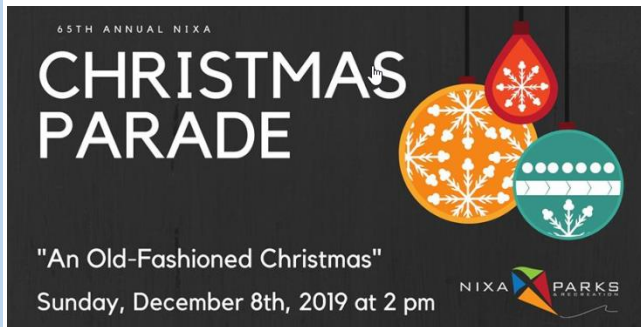
