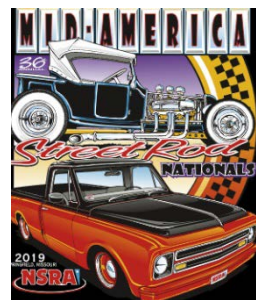
This festival runs August 9-10. Details follow later in the year.

NSRA Mid-America Street Rod Nationals

The NSRA Mid-America Street Rod Nationals was held in Springfield and an all-time high number of participants and spectators were expected this year. Almost all of the Ozark Empire Fairgrounds will be utilized for the event as well as many of the buildings, which will house a large number of manufacturer and dealer displays and other attractions.

The host organization, NSRA, defines a street rod as a modernized vintage vehicle that must be of pre 1949 manufacture. These vehicles are equipped with the latest options available on the newest model

vehicles, including but not limited to disc brakes, air conditioning, cruise control, and tilt steering wheel. Most of those attending have updated the engine and drive train to enable the owner to cruise down the highway in comfort and safely maintain the speeds traveled by more modern vehicles. All vehicles must be driven on to the grounds.



Included in this event are muscle cars, those factories produced high horsepower machines from the 60's and 70's along with the classics cars of the 50's. This is truly unique mix of old and new together for the first time at Ozark Empire Fairgrounds and a national gathering of fine vintage automobiles of every description. The NSRA Mid-America Street Rod Nationals is the area's largest automotive participation event and spectators from around the area will attend the event.

The NSRA Mid-America Street Rod Nationals is an excellent event for spectators to attend and those who take time to attend will be treated to the sights and sounds of some of the most beautiful, best constructed vintage vehicles ever assembled in one place. One of the special attractions for the spectators is that they can walk right up to the vehicles and check each one out close up as they are not roped-off or otherwise confined. All are in the open and can be examined top to bottom, front to back, inside and out. While the exquisite paint and other features of the car should not be touched, spectators are free to look to their hearts content.

Mitchell cars were produced from 1902 to 1923. Prior to that the company produced wagons, bicycles and motorcycles. In addition to the cars there were also wagons, a bicycle and a motorcycle at the museum.

Roslyn Heights Mansion was built in 1895 by wealthy Boonville couple Mr. and Mrs. Wilbur T Johnson. The home is now the state headquarters of the Daughters of the American Revolution.

The Warm Springs Ranch is the home of the Budweiser Clydesdale horses and is the breeding farm and hitch training facility. The group was fortunate enough to see four newborn foals which were only four days old.

Remember When.....

A fun romp through the decades as we approach our clubs 45th anniversary in July 2020.

Highlights from 1936-1940...

Members with cars from these years are Jim and Donna Meyer with a 1936 Ford Humpback Sedan. The 1936 Ford style differed only slightly from the 1935 model with a longer, more pointed hood and a more sharply vee'd grill to match. 1937 brought crisp new bodies with the headlamps nestled in the fenders.

In 1936 Chevy adopted the "Turret Top" construction that eliminated old-fashioned fabric roof inserts. Chevy also offered hydraulic brakes for the first year which Ford wouldn't offer until 1939.

The strength of Ford and General Motors grew during these years. The late 1930's saw a consolidation of car manufacturers with only four major independents remaining by 1940. They were Nash, Hudson, Packard and Studebaker. (Information adapted from *Encyclopedia of American Cars*)

In Springfield and around the state....

- In 1938 the Rail Haven Motor Court opened in Springfield and became a Route 66 icon.

Nationally.....

- The dirigible airship Hindenburg explodes in the sky above Lakehurst, New Jersey in 1937.
- Amelia Earhart disappears
- Hughes Sets New "Around the World" Record - Howard Hughes set a new around-the-world record; at 3 days, 19 hours and 8 minutes in 1938.
- After the advent of talking pictures ("talkies") in 1927 and full color films in 1930: more than 50 classic films were made in the 1930s: most notable were *Gone with The Wind* and *The Wizard of Oz*.

Nationally and around the World.....

- Spanish Civil War Breaks Out in 1936.
- In 1937 the US Army gets 1st B-17, the US Army Air Corps received the first of its order of 13 B-17 bombers. These four-engine bombers could cruise at 256 mph, at an altitude of 30,000 feet. The B-17 was to be the main US strategic bomber in Europe during World War II.
- Germany Seizes Austria in 1937.
- Germany invades Poland
- Great Britain and France declared war on Germany

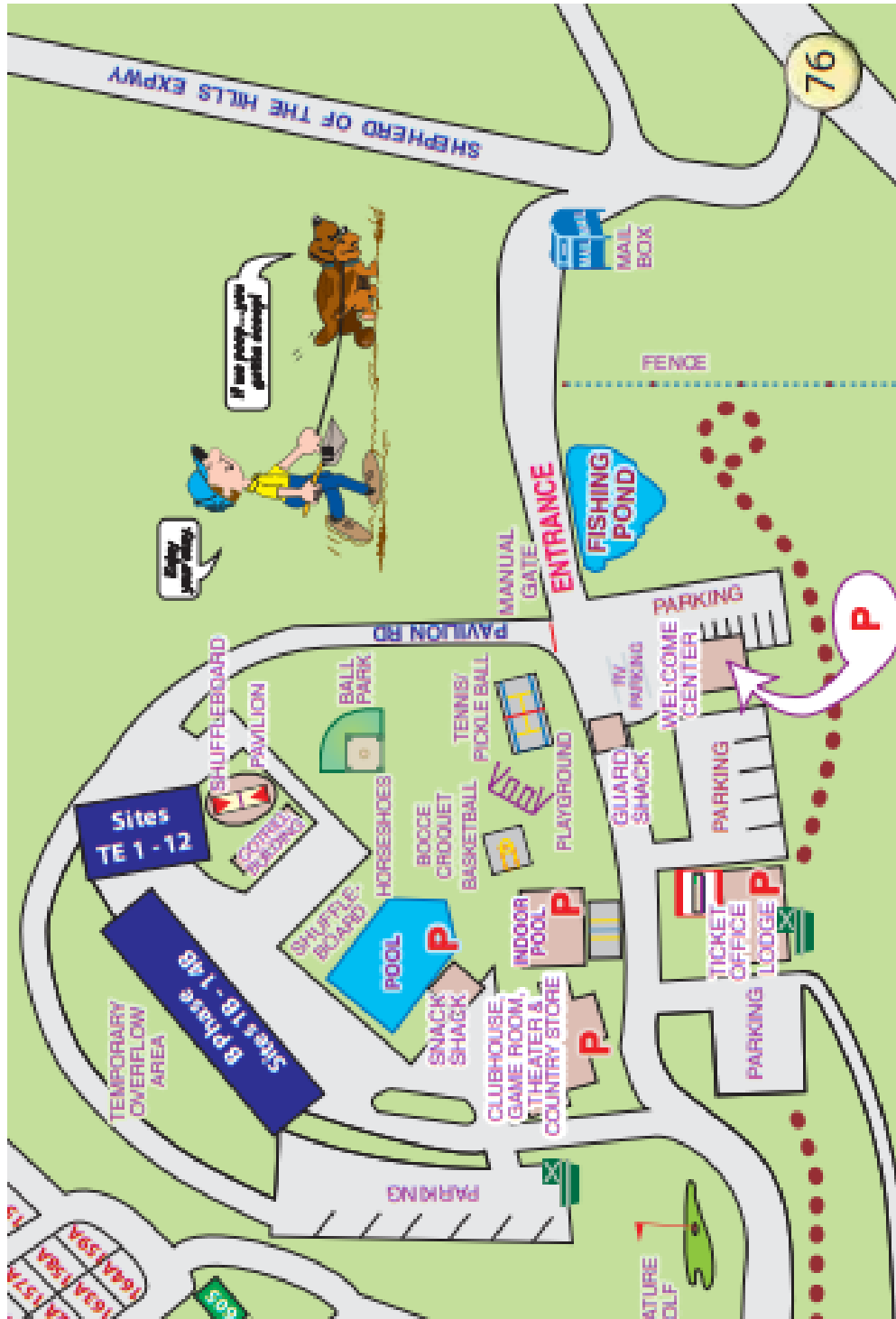

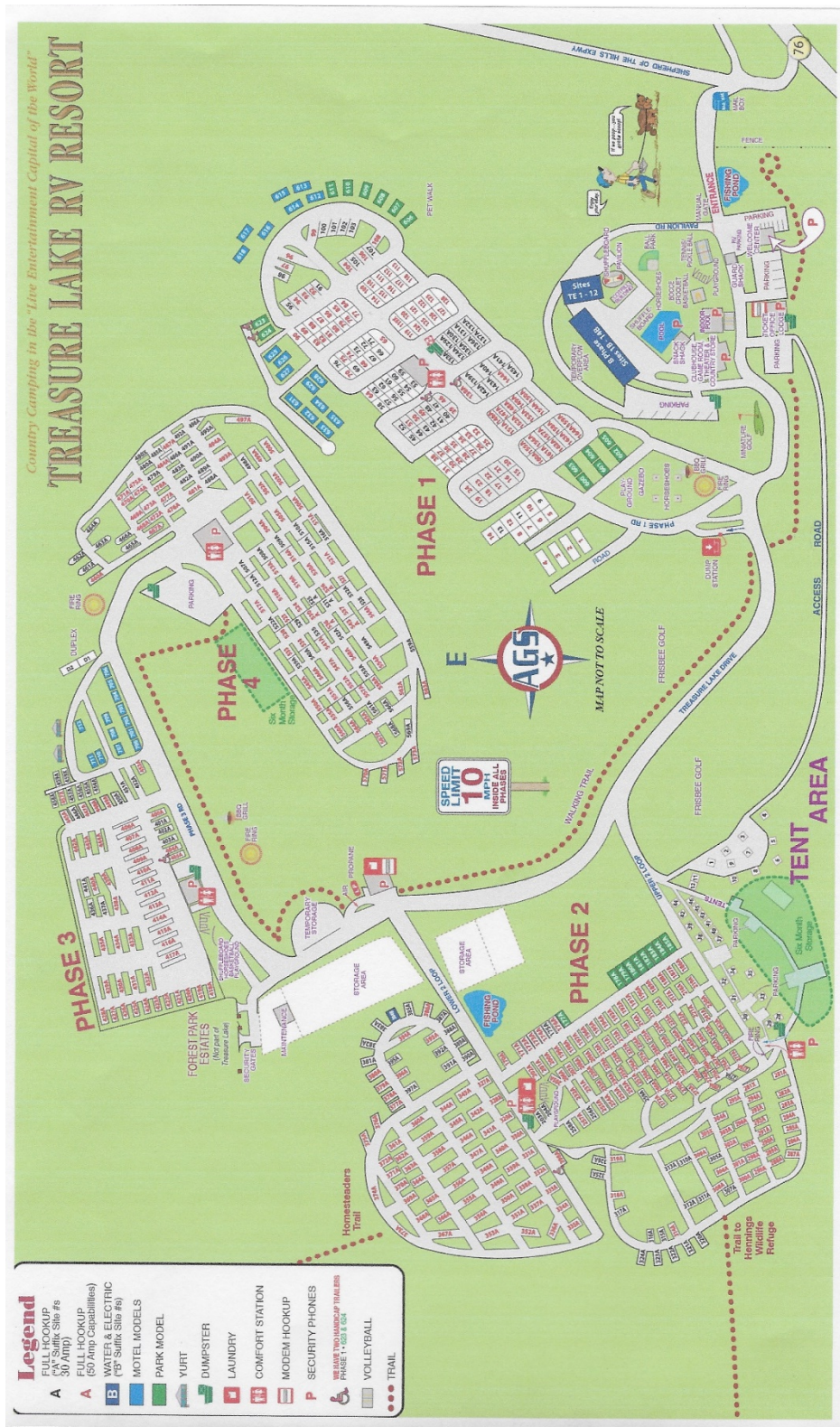

Ralph Foster was one of the true pioneers of radio. He was one of the first to realize its vast potential, both educationally and as a new and exciting field of mass entertainment.

In 1924, Ralph Foster and his partner, Jerry Hall, set up a 50-watt station, KGBX, in a corner of their Firestone tire store in St. Joseph, Missouri.

It began simply as a hobby, but as businesses increasingly sought to advertise over the air, the station blossomed into a full-time vocation. It wasn't long before a brand new one-stop super service station and glassed in studios for the radio station were built a few blocks north of the old tire store located on Frederick Avenue. The age of radio had begun!

In 1932, Ralph Foster moved the station to Springfield, Missouri. Later, unable to get a power increase for KGBX, he purchased the license of a radio station in Grant City, Missouri, and moved it to Springfield.

Ralph Foster asked for and received the call letter KWTQ and soon the slogan

"Keep Watching The Ozarks" was on everybody's lips. Ralph Foster, as president and general manager of KWTQ, devoted all his time and energy toward making KWTQ the dominant station of the Ozarks area. KGBX was sold in the early 1940's.

Live talent broadcasts dominated programming. Many famous country music stars either got their start or appeared on KWTQ, such as Slim Wilson, Porter Wagoner, Chet Atkins, the Carter family, and Homer and Jethro.

The long popular weekly television show, OZARK JUBILEE, was a Ralph Foster achievement through Crossroads TV Production, a KWTQ subsidiary. It starred Red Foley and guest starred many well known country music personalities.

For many years, Ralph Foster had been collecting Native American artifacts. His interest in The School of the Ozarks prompted him to turn this vast collection over to The School's museum.

Because of his abiding interests and generosity, The School of the Ozarks Board of Trustees voted to rename the museum the "Ralph Foster Museum" in the mid-1960's.

Ralph Foster passed away on August 11, 1984. His wife Harriett passed away on December 5, 1986.

Who was Ralph Foster? He was an avid hunter and fisherman, a strong conservationist; a man who was close to nature, one who loved his fellow man. He was compassionate, understanding, generous, and had a rich sense of humor.

EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Ralph Foster Museum offers several educational programs for the younger museum visitors. A hands-on Children's Discovery Room is available free of charge to children ages 4-9 and is open Monday through Friday. A one child/one adult ratio is required to visit the Discovery Room or a four to one ratio for school groups is required. Reservations for the room are required for school groups.

Loan kits are available for area schools, which contain artifacts, text, audio, and worksheets, and may be loaned to a class for a period of five days. A brochure is available which lists the kit contents and loan instructions.

Educational groups are welcome at the Ralph Foster Museum. We ask that you call the museum in advance to arrange your self guided tour. The museum provides a packet of information for each student to make their visit more interesting.
