The Branson Auction convenes in April (12th & 13th) and October (TBA) at the convention center in Branson. The cars on the auction block include a myriad of automobiles that span nearly 100 years.

The convention center is set up with an auction room where the bidding takes place and a large hall where the cars are staged. It's a great venue to see the cars. All the cars are listed in a brochure that visitors receive when they enter. It is available on-line, too. There is easy access to the staging area and all the cars can be viewed up close.

The results of the bidding are available on-line within a couple of days after the auction closes. So, owners of classics can compare value of their cars to the those that sold.

It's also a great venue to people watch.

The Branson Auction has a great webpage where you can see what cars are being auctioned and later to view what the bids were. If you wish, you can sign up to receive email alerts as to what cars have recently been consigned. Preparation Checklist

It was tough sledding for cars this winter. In many areas of the country, drivers faced snowstorms, below-zero temperatures and potholes — conditions not conducive for healthy cars. But with spring on the horizon, automotive professionals say it's a good time to take your car in for a tuneup. Warm up to these five spring car maintenance tips:



- 1 Remove leftover salt**
 - That white stuff caked on the roads to melt ice and snow can cause serious damage to cars, especially on their undercarriages where metal can rust. Take your car to a highly rated carwash to eliminate salt, and make sure the business has sprayers that clean the undercarriage.
- 2 Check alignment and suspension**
 - Driving over potholes can make for a rough ride. You might notice the car pulls to one side or the steering vibrates as you drive. An alignment check typically costs \$25 to \$40.
- 3 Change oil and check fluids**
 - Mechanics recommend oil changes about every 5,000 miles. Spring is also an ideal time to flush your transmission fluid and check window washing fluid levels, as well as your brake and cooling system fluids. Experts say spring is also a good time to inspect lights, belts and the windshield wipers.
- 4 Rotate tires and check air pressure**
 - Be sure to check the tire pressure, including the spare. Mechanics recommend tire rotations every 5,000 miles to keep treadwear even.
- 5 Inspect brakes**
 - Nothing, perhaps, is more important. Have a technician check the pads and rotors so there is no safety issues. Neglecting them can lead to a costlier repair down the line.

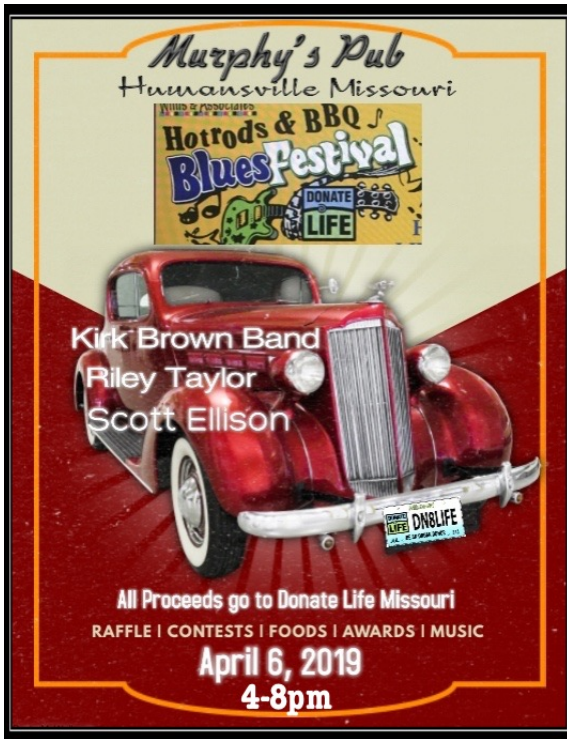
