LINZER COOKIES. The Linzertorte is one of the oldest known tarts with a recipe discovered in an Austrian abbey from 1653. Johann Konrad Vogel (1796-1883) is credited with first mass producing it while Franz Holzhuber, an Austrian émigré who worked as a baker, is recognized for introducing it to America around 1856.

Black or Red Currant jam is the traditional filling. I used my own homemade blackberry jam which comes from my berry bushes. I didn't have a personal history with the cookie, just a new recipe I wanted to try."

1955 started the "coveted collectibles" of the tri-five era. Designers, working under Harley Earl, crafted an entirely new look. When paired with the new 265 V-8 motor this new model became known as "the hot one" through marketing. Available in the 150, 210 and Bel Air with each offering numerous options such as two door, four door and wagon versions. Another newcomer was the Bel Air Nomad, America's first "hardtop wagon" with a first year production of 8386. (Information adapted from *The Encyclopedia of American Cars*.)

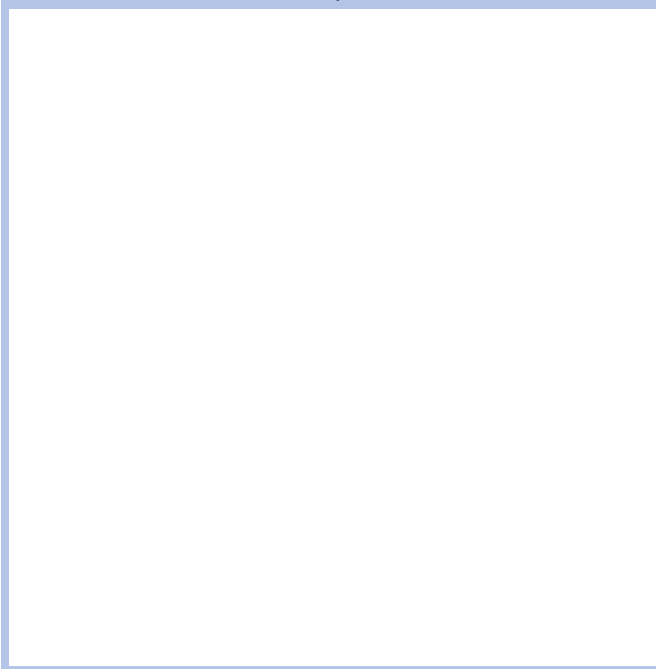

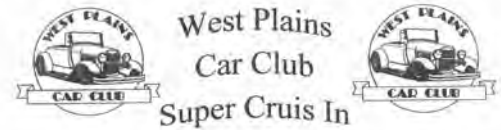
